In cooperation with the Kansas Scenic Byways and the Kansas Lottery, the Barton County Arts Council will be hosting an event with Kansas artist Stan Herd, Saturday, August 29, at Dozier Winery, 323 SE 80 Avenue, south of Ellinwood, from 1:00 to 9:00 p.m.

Area artists are invited to join Mr. Herd for a day of plein air art in their choice of media. Dozier Winery features pleasant, well-shaded areas, walking trails, a picturesque old Santa Fe depot-turned-winery, and, of course, the vineyard itself.

This event is part of a series designed to feature the nine scenic byways in our state. The Kansas Lottery is promoting the byways through a scratch card game with a top prize of \$10,000. However, at a second-chance drawing in November, non-winning tickets will be eligible to win one of nine paintings by Mr. Herd featuring each of the Kansas byways.
